# **CFSEK Completes Fifth Challenge Early**

Thank you to each and every donor who helped the CFSEK to complete the GROW Phase V Challenge from the Kansas Health Foundation. The Challenge required the CFSEK to raise \$700,000 in new endowment funds and \$50,000 in new operating funds. Due to our success, the CFSEK will be receiving \$350,000 to be placed in the KHF Children's Endowment Fund (managed by the CFSEK) and \$100,000 to be placed in the newly formed CFSEK Operating Endowment Fund.

Originally, the Challenge was to run through December of 2009. In early Fall 2007, the KHF announced plans to offer a Bonus Challenge to those community foundations that could complete Phase V by December 31, 2007. The Bonus Challenge encourages community foundations to work with school foundations to build endowment dollars. The CFSEK will be releasing more information regarding this opportunity in late Spring.

CFSEK has participated in the Kansas Health Foundation GROW initiatives since 2001. The GROW (Giving Resources to Our World) Healthy Kansas Initiative is a partnership between the Kansas Health Foundation and a select group of community foundations throughout the state of Kansas. The Kansas Health Foundation believes that Kansas community foundations build and strengthen their communities.

The Community Foundation is excited to participate in the 2008 Walk Kansas program. The kick-off for Walk Kansas will be Friday, March 7<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 pm at the Girard High School Track.

Walk Kansas is sponsored by the Crawford County Extension Office. It is a program "that motivates people of all ages to make the most important change...to get started." Team members will pool the mileage they walk each week to work their way across Kansas (423 miles!!). This year Walk Kansas is also focusing on the importance of fruits and vegetables in the daily diet, asking teams to record the number of daily servings consumed.
