

Youth Organization Volunteerism Grant

Overview:

The Dylan Meier Get Busy Livin' Foundation (<u>www.getbusylivin.org</u>) established a competitive granting process to provide grants (up to \$500) to be used for the purpose of any and all future activities relating to youth volunteerism. Describe the volunteer activity and explain how the funds will help you complete your worthy cause.

Project examples: trash pickup, neighborhood park improvements, cleanup elderly properties, assisting at hospitals, nursing homes, working on recycling projects, animal care programs, tree planting, etc. A list of awarded grant projects from the previous year can be found at southeastkansas.org.

Reimbursable expense examples: Project costs, miscellaneous supplies, travel expenditures, entry fees, advertising, etc.

The grant recipient must be a 501(c)3, school, unit of government, or religious organization. Examples of eligible organizations include: Boy/Girl Scouts, FFA chapters, church youth groups, school clubs, YMCA, JL Hutchinson League, etc. If you need to verify if your group qualifies to receive a grant, please contact the Community Foundation of Southeast Kansas (CFSEK).

Only future projects will be funded. Reimbursement will occur after the project is completed and the Activity Completion Form is submitted.
