2023 has been an exciting year here at the Community Foundation of Southeast Kansas! We launched our new Making a Difference grant cycle and have continued to help area nonprofits achieve their goals while adding several new funds into the fold!

Our scholarship process also continued to grow this year. This year, we gave \$102,000 to 63 area students! We also have several new scholarship opportunities that will be available next year.

Not only that, but we've also hosted our Estate Planning Forum in June and will be partnering with PHS Launch to help research our focus for next year's Making a Difference grant: Housing.

And there's still plenty to come, including our Women's Health Fund grant cycle, our second round of the Making a Difference in Childcare - Bourbon County in September, and our annual Grant Celebration and Match Day fundraiser in November! In late August, CFSEK announced that it had awarded \$5,000 to four daycares in Cherokee County as part of its Making A Difference in Childcare campaign.

The grants addressed what CFSEK Executive Director Devin Gorman called "a critical need" in Southeast Kansas communities, explaining: "Our Board of Trustees wanted to explore ways that CFSEK could assist some of our current childcare providers and ensure that they can continue to provide their critical services."

Based on data provided by the State of Kansas and Child Care Aware, the Foundation selected Cherokee County for its first round of Making A Difference grants. CFSEK partnered with its affiliate, the Columbus Area

Community Foundation, the local health department, and Child Care Aware to notify licensed childcare providers of the grant opportunity.

Applicants were asked to identify the areas of greatest need for their children. As a result of this one-time grant, the following daycares received funding for the following projects:

- **Highland Daycare:** Outdoor equipment.
- **Kayas Kids:** Rugs, bouncer, and nap mats.
- **Kiddie Garden Daycare:** Outdoor equipment.
- Little Blessing Daycare:
 Outdoor toys, storage, and nap
 mats.
