The two giving circles granted a combined \$59,205, with the Women's Giving Circle awarding \$51,705 to nine organizations and the Circle of Friends Giving Circle awarding \$7,500 to four.

- **Coffeyville Regional Medical Center Foundation** will purchase a new fetal-monitor system.
- **CHC/SEK** will acquire ultrasound equipment to train students to provide prenatal care.
- Fostering Connections will provide college care packages for young women aging out of foster care.
- Horses of Hope Riding Center will develop the Georgia Becker Memorial Trail.


2024 grants (cont.)

- Hospital District 1 Crawford County Foundation will purchase an ultrasound system for the Girard Medical Center clinic in Frontenac.
- Safehouse will provide essential household items to help women survivors of domestic violence.
- Wilson Medical Center Foundation will provide free mammograms to 10 uninsured women age 40 and up.

Circle of Friends Grants

- Catholic Charities will provide furniture and household items to women survivors of domestic violence.
- Families and Children Together will host "Mom's Night Out" events to help mothers manage stress and promote good mental health.
- Ronald McDonald House Charities of the Four States will provide specialized nursing kits to support mothers with babies in the NICU.
- SEK Women Helping Women will provide funding for dental-care services to women.
