What do I need to have ready to apply for a scholarship?

Applying for CFSEK scholarships is a two-step process: first, you complete a general application form. Then, based on your answers on the general form, you'll be given a list of CFSEK scholarships you're eligible for. There will be supplemental tasks and documentation you'll have to complete or upload to finish applying for any individual scholarship. Having this information on hand will make your application process much smoother.

- General application information:
 - GPA(s)
 - High School class ranking
 - Graduation date(s)
 - College, University, or technical school attending next semester
 - ACT, GED, and/or SAT scores
 - Parent/Guardian information (including name, phone number, and email address)
 - Activities and recognitions (if you've participated) (including start and end dates)
 - School, community, and/or work history
 - Degree plans
 - Financial plans
 - FAFSA Student Aid Index Score
 - Other scholarships or grants
 - Employment and/or housing plans
 - Other financial circumstances that would impact your need for a scholarship
 - Estimated annual cost of attendance at your selected institution (including tuition, fees, books, supplies/equipment required for degree) (do not include housing, meal plan/food, or transportation)
- General application upload(s)
 - High School transcript (Needs to include your name and school name for verification)
 - College transcript (Needs to include your name and school name for verification) (if you attended college classes as an applicant)
- Supplemental (scholarship-specific) (you will see these once your general application has been submitted)
 - Essay questions
 - Third-party letter(s) of recommendation (up to 3 from either non-family members or co-workers/patients)
 - Documentation of acceptance into certain programs
